Grand High Priest's Message "CONNECT * COMMUNICATE * COMMITMENT"

Greetings Companions,

My first activity for June was to travel to Comptche at Mendocino to welcome the candidates and the companions. This was the first time since the Pandemic to have the Comptche Festival. It was also the first time it happened to have the Council Degree in Comptche. Normally, we only confer the Capitular Degrees. It was a great feeling to have a very nice camaraderie and fellowship with the companions and the new candidates. We exalted 19 new Companions, and greeted 29 Companions with the Cryptic Degrees. I ask our new Companions to "Connect with your blue lodge brothers, to continue to Communicate about York Rite Masonry -- especially the Royal Arch and make a Commitment to yourself and to your Chapter." Let your Chapter officers know that you are ready to help increase membership.

On June 29, 2023, I traveled to Southern California to attend the Grand Bethel Convention in Ontario, California. I spoke regarding the Scholarship Program we have for the youth groups. The deadline for the Scholarship Program was this last March. This year, we have 9 scholarship recipients -- 3 were new and 6 renewals.

On July 2, 2023, I will be in San Luis Obispo for the 3 Way Reception/Ice Cream Social. The following day, another 3 Way reception in Van Nuys, CA, and the parade. WOW!!! This is so exciting, a lot of travel!

Companions, as I have mentioned in my June article, my goal is to increase membership. How do we do it? We must continue to have Mark Master Degrees. I am looking forward that each district will have a degree team. On July 19, 2023, District 14, California Chapter No.1 will collaborate with Columbia Brotherhood Lodge No.370, and they will be hosting a Mark Master Degree. So far, they have 10 candidates signed up -- meaning, 10 candidates for follow-up to become Royal Arch Masons.

Finally, I plan to have an education seminar for ritual and administration. I will direct the Department Grand Officers to set up a School of Instruction. Companions, read the WORKMAN for more information regarding any future events. "Holiness to the Lord." God bless you all!

Nineteen candidates were exalted in the Royal Arch degree on Saturday, June 24th! Ten more were added for the Cryptic Degrees on Sunday, June 25th, making a total of Twenty-nine greeted!! This was the first time in recent memory that Cryptic degrees were conferred on a Sunday, the Constitution having been revised last year to allow such conferrals.

The food provided at the camp-site was excellent, particularly the rib-eye steaks on Saturday night! The Camaraderie was high, and several Companions stepped up at the last minute to fill roles when a cast member was unable to attend – notably, Rich Lyons as Master of the First Veil, Jason Canellos as Senior Deacon in the Past Master degree, and Cameron Williams as Hiram of Tyre in the Select Master degree.

You should put the weekend of June 22 – 23 on your calendar in 2024. Bring your family as well as candidates – there is plenty of room for RVs in the large meadow across from the cook shack, as you can see in pictures nearby. There are also well-shaded camp sites around the area as well, so bring your tents, if you like to rough-it! Although there are no RV hookups, there are restroom facilities on the site. Finally, there are numerous motels and hotels on the coast, only 9 miles from the camp-site, if you prefer those luxuries!

The ladies and kids are welcome to drive to the coast and enjoy the numerous opportunities for site-seeing and shopping, from Mendocino to Ft. Bragg, while the guys are doing their degree work.



SECRETARY and/or RECORDER ESSENTIALS -- REVISED

Forms and Documents you will need are located at the Grand York Rite website, which is: www.yorkriteofcalifornia.org. The new website will require you to have a userid, and to have established a password. Once you LOGIN, you will see a long white line, above which you will see:

ROYAL ARCH FORMS CRYPTIC COUNCIL FORMS COMMANDERY FORMS

Then click on the appropriate FORMS. In ROYAL ARCH FORMS, scroll down to Officers Manual, which has information for the Secretary, and print that out. Many concepts in the Grand Chapter manual are relevant to Councils and Commanderies.

Priorities are as follows:

- 1. <u>Dues Collection</u> You should send out dues notices no later than October, with payments from members due by December 31st.
- 2. <u>Membership control</u> Membership information is now managed in the MMS system Masonic Membership Solutions. Important changes to your membership include new members, suspensions, demits, and deaths. Maintain e-mail addresses for members and you can easily then forward the monthly newsletter, The WORKMAN, to them.
- 3. Do not cavalierly suspend members for non-payment of dues. There is a Constitutional process that should be followed rigorously in order that members, who may have moved and not received your dues notice, are treated fairly. See the following sections of the relevant Constitution in order to learn about this process:

- 4. Per Capita -- The Per Capita payment, due each Jan 15th for Chapter and Councils (and April 1st for Commanderies) does not require action by the Chapter, Council or Commandery to be paid. You will need good, up-to-date end-of-year numbers of active members in MMS. This is the source of your Per Capita bill. Without good data on your membership in MMS you will most likely overpay your per capita requirement. It is sensible to begin your process near the end of the CY, as soon as possible. It is also sensible, if you have access to the Grand Lodge database, to check each member to see if they are still alive. Do so before the end of the year. But most important is getting a userid to utilize MMS so you can enter deceased and suspended data.
- 5. <u>Insurance</u> -- The Insurance payment, due each July 15th, does not require action by the Chapter, Council or Commandery to be paid. You will be billed for the payment by the Grand Secretary or Grand Recorder.
- 6. <u>Lodge Book of Marks</u> Maintain this up-to-date, or perhaps arrange for a PHP to take on the responsibility of maintaining.
- 7. Minutes Take good minutes, but don't over-do it by trying to capture everything that is said. Focus on having a clear representation of motions made and the vote count by which they passed or failed. In addition to keeping petitions in a separate file, it is good practice to replicate the basic petitioner information in the minutes. It is also a good practice to keep the names of attendees at each meeting in the minutes. If conferring a degree, keep a copy of the cast members and the candidate(s). Also, please send the candidate class names to the Grand Secretary or Grand Recorder.
- 8. <u>Grand Sessions</u> Before the May meeting, remind the Dais officers they are responsible to attend; and arrange a stipend if your Chapter, Council or Commandery can afford it. Remind members who expect to attend to be sure to take their dues cards. If Dais Officers of the Chapter and Council cannot attend, they may issue a proxy, or they may elect a representative. This is true also for Commanderies, whose members, however, cannot issue proxies. The appropriate Chapter forms can be obtained on the Grand York Rite website: Scroll to "Elected Representative and Proxy Credentials." Or, alternatively, the forms for all three bodies can be found at www.ca-gyrs.org.
- 9. Order of High Priesthood Be sure the current HP and PHPs know they are eligible to receive this Order. In fact, it is a Constitutional requirement! Share the petition with them and send to the Grand Secretary. This requirement does not appear to be true for the Thrice Illustrious Master Degree or the Past Commander's Association. Petitions for all three bodies are available at the www.ca-gyrs.org.




